Once a vibrant waterway for commerce, the river now is a recreational spot for boaters, fisherman, photographers, and artists of all ages.

It is also our water supply and a wonderful place for students to learn ecology and science.

- seats 49 passengers in covered and open decks.
- is US Coast Guard certified with US Coast Guard licensed Captain and crew
- is complete with marine safety equipment
- has docks in Lambertville, NJ and New Hope, PA
- is available for school and youth groups, special occasion charters such as birthdays, weddings, anniversaries, or just a good time with family and friends!
- cost is \$19 per person with a minimum of \$695.
- cruising dates are May through October
- tours last 1-2 hours with anchoring upstream for student activities or lunch or supper
- *and* when on board be sure to visit the engine area!
