As the whistle blows, this real stern-wheeler takes your scouts on a voyage of fun and learning. **SPLASH** takes passengers back to George Washington's crossing the Delaware and the Fitch's invention of the steamboat, to wildlife that inhabit the water and shores and to the source of drinking water for 17 million people. **SPLASH** is a Coast Guard certified replica of a local 1880 steamboat, boarding in Lambertville, NJ, and carrying 49 passengers. Educational activities include interactive watershed model, water testing, water physics (steam engine), water safety, bird spotting and historical role-playing, geared to specific scout requirements.
